

Troop 964 Waterskiing Campout

Dates: August 7-8, 2010 (Overnight Saturday Only)

Location: Christopher Run Campground, 7149 Zachary Taylor Hwy, Mineral VA, 23117 (540) 894-4744.

Costs: Total Costs: \$40. A maximum of \$15 per scout may be used for food. The campground charges \$8 for each camper for the nights. The remaining funds will boat launch fees (\$16) and cover gas for the boats and the vehicle that tow them. The fees may be adjusted depending on attendance. Scouts must pay the campout fee and have a signed permission slip turned in by the end of the meeting on August 3rd in order to attend. Money is also due by August 3rd. Troop dues must also be paid through August 2010. Cancellations after August 3rd will not receive a refund for the food cost only.

Departure Time: Please be at the Church at 7:00 AM on Saturday to load up, then we will proceed to Christopher Run Campground. We will leave the Church promptly at 7:30AM. We will return to the Church on Sunday at approximately 5PM.

Activities: Two-day water sports Campout at Lake Anna, about 60 miles from Dale City. We will water ski, wake board & perhaps tube. We will provide the opportunity for Scouts to work on the Water Sports Merit Badge & some may be able to complete it! Our campground will be near the water so there'll be plenty of opportunity to swim and to fish as well. We will have a troop campfire Saturday night if the boys are not too tired. You must have completed the 2010 swim test or be accompanied by a parent.

Clothing/Equipment: Check the weather report for appropriate clothing. Scouts must wear their Class "A" uniform to/from the campout. In accordance with troop policy, Scouts must also bring their own eating utensils (plate, bowl, cup, and knife/fork/spoon) and other camping equipment listed in the Boy Scout Manual. Please bring a container for drinking water during the day, sunscreen and insect repellent if you use it. Patrol leaders must ensure they have sufficient tents for their patrol.

Meals: Patrols should plan for meals for lunch and dinner on Saturday and breakfast and lunch on Sunday. Meal plans and duty rosters must be checked by the SPL.

Adults: Mr. VanSkiver is bringing the boat, we will need another vehicle to pull the troop trailer. A minimum of three adults will be required to provide safety & two-deep supervision (a CPR trained adult for Mr. Van Skiver's boat & at least one responsible adult to watch the waterfront while the boat is out). We highly recommend more—it's a great weekend & a beautiful campsite!
